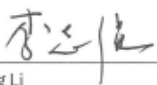
ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

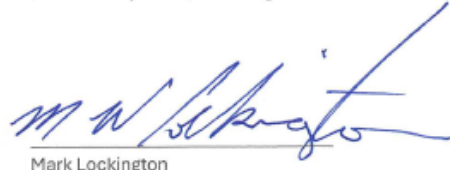
